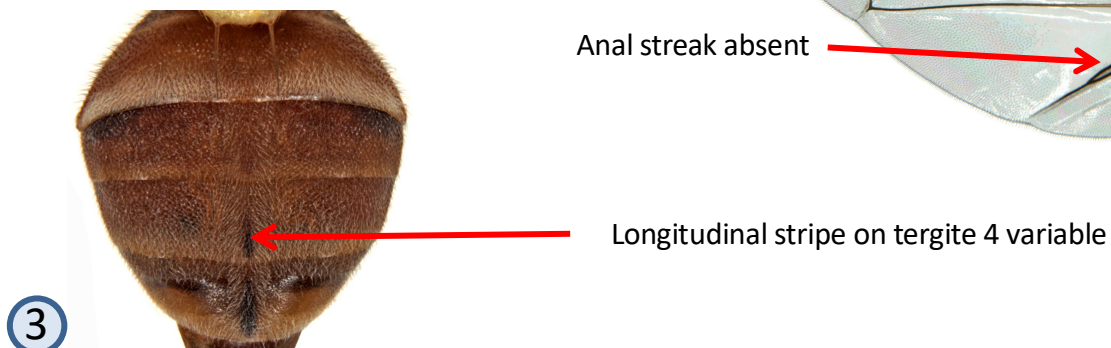
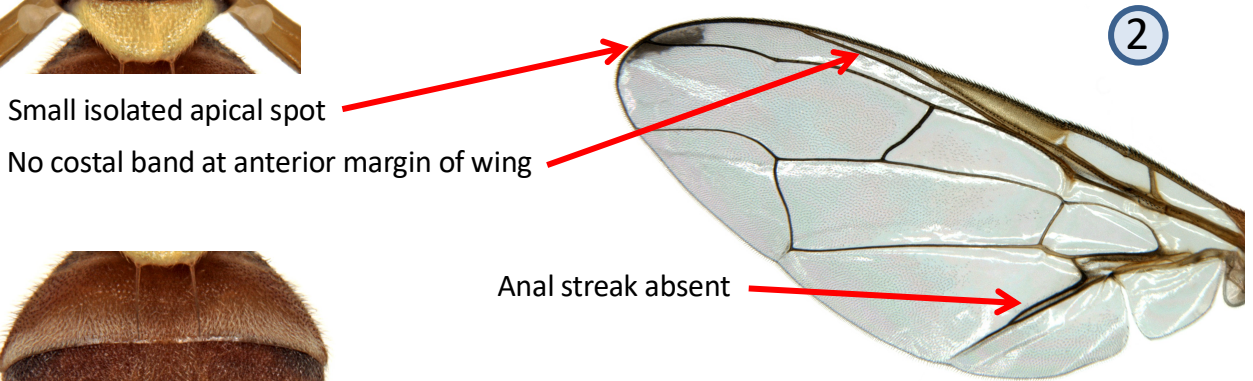
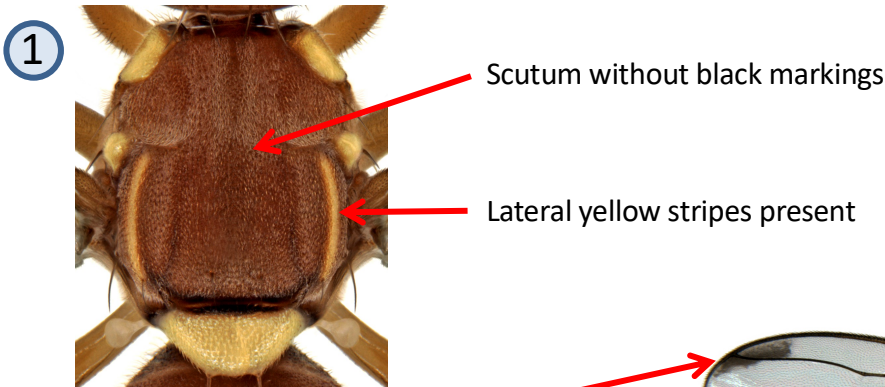
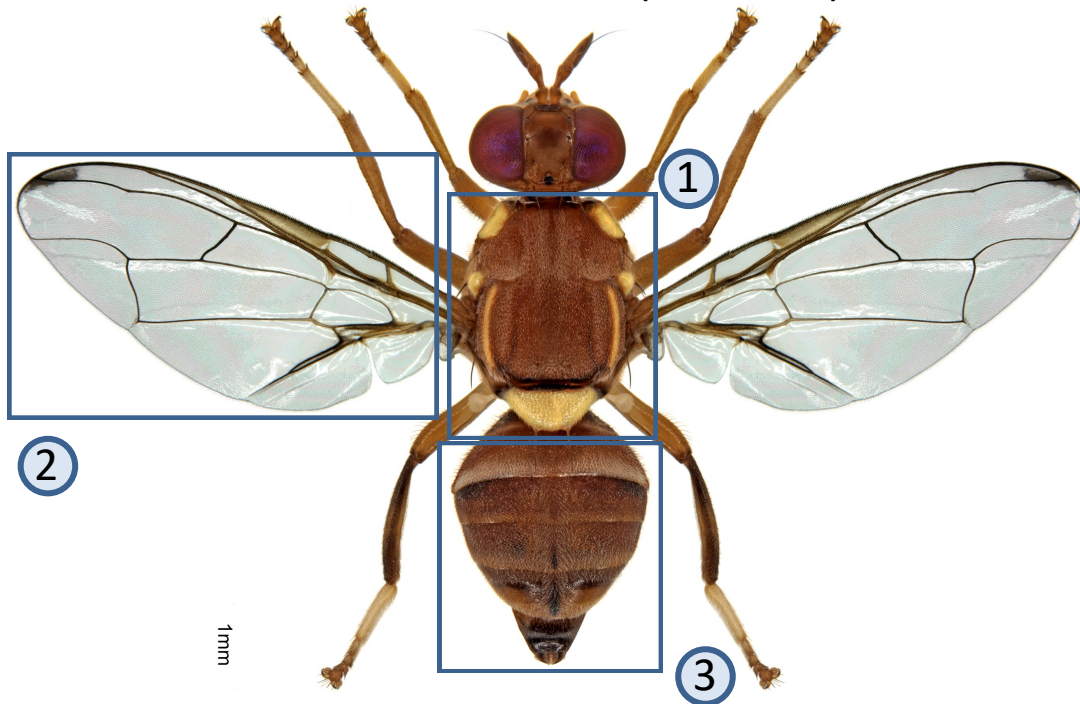


Bactrocera zonata (Saunders)



Peach fruit fly. Medium size (wing length 5.2-6.1 mm). Polyphagous species with limited host plant records in Africa. The pest is native to South/Southeast Asia and has started to invade eastern/northern Africa. Both sexes can be trapped with liquid protein baits. Males are attracted to methyl eugenol.
