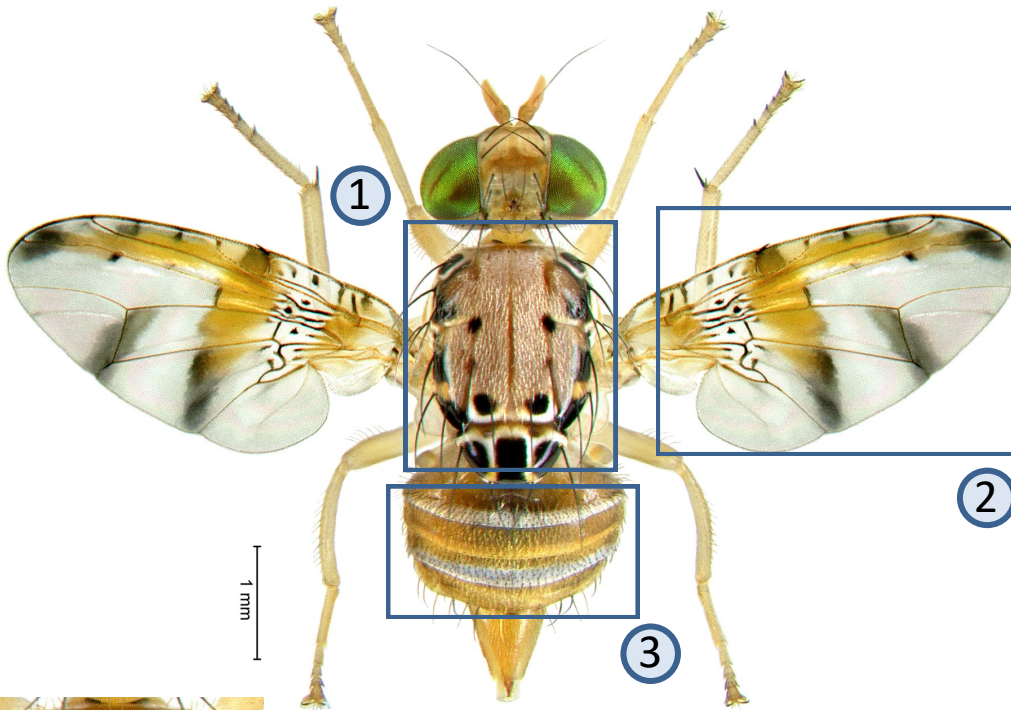
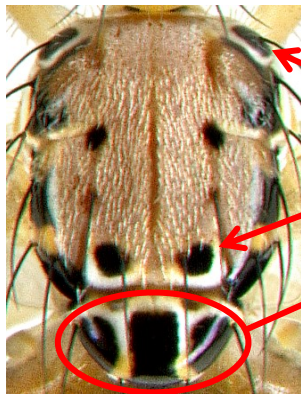


Ceratitis cosyra (Walker)

Postpronotal lobe with black spot around bristle

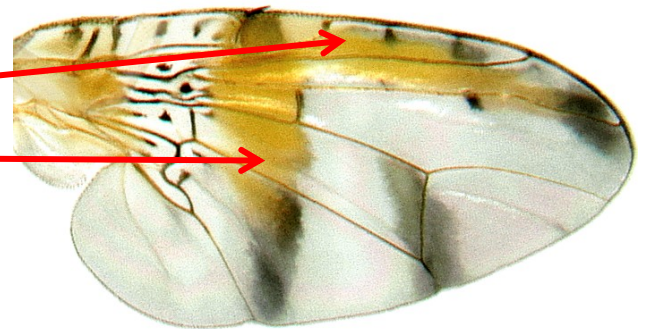
Black spot around prescutellar bristle

Apical margin scutellum with three separated black spots

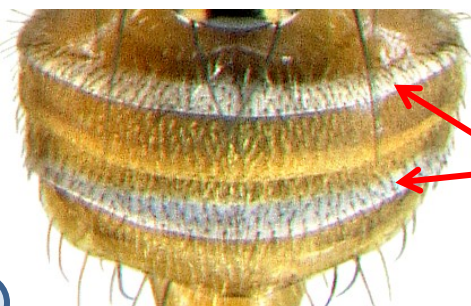

Mango fruit fly, marula fruit fly. Medium size (body length 4-6 mm). Polyphagous. Main *Ceratitis* pest on mango. Widespread throughout sub-Saharan Africa. Both sexes can be attracted by protein bait products. Males respond to terpinyl acetate and Enriched Ginger Oil (EGO) lure.
